

RESOLUTION NO. 1286

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS, COUNTY OF COCONINO, ARIZONA, RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 929

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance No. 929 on July 26, 2012, increasing the retail sales tax and eliminating the food tax; and

WHEREAS, the City posted with insufficient notice the proposed tax changes on its website as required by A.R.S. §9-499.15; and


WHEREAS, the insufficient notice renders the proposed changes invalid; and


WHEREAS, the City Code Article 2-1.05, Rule 17, allows the Council to rescind any Ordinance by an affirmative vote of a majority of all Council members, but in no event by less than four (4) affirmative votes; and

THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of Williams, Arizona, that effective Tuesday, September 25, 2012, Ordinance No. 929 is hereby **Rescinded**, and shall be of no further force or effect.
